



Getting to Vandon House from Heathrow Airport

From Heathrow Airport there are three main options for getting to Vandon House: Underground, Taxi or Shuttlebus.

Underground

1) Take the tube (subway) - this will cost about £4 and takes about 1 hour.

Follow the signs for the London Underground from the arrivals hall. The ticket required is a single to Zone 1. Take the Piccadilly Line (only option from Heathrow) to Hammersmith or Barons Court and change to the eastbound District Line. This leaves from the opposite side of the platform so there are no steps to master with heavy luggage. Leave the train at St James's Park station.

Please note that St James's Park station has two exits. It is advisable to use the Victoria Street exit.

Broadway (main exit)

On leaving the station Vandon House is a two minute walk. Turn left onto Petty France and walk past the Adam and Eve Pub and then turn left into Vandon Passage, at the end of the passage turn right and Vandon House is on the corner.

Victoria Street

On leaving the station, Vandon House is a one minute walk. Turn left onto Palmer Street, then right onto Caxton Street, then right onto Vandon Street. Vandon House is around the corner on the right.

This exit is open Monday to Friday from 0730 hours to 1930 hours.

Taxi

2) Vandon House can organise a taxi which will cost about £45. A taxi will comfortably take two people + luggage for this price.

Shuttlebus

3) Take a shuttle bus, which is run by an independent company but can be booked through Vandon House and takes you door-to-door. (If you are arriving after 2100 hours this will not be an option.) If you choose this method Vandon House will need the following information - flight number and time, arrival date and name of passengers - in order to book the shuttle. Once booked Vandon House will send confirmation and further instructions of where to find the shuttle, etc...
